Job Description:

A Behavioral Technician provides guidance, mentoring, and social/life skills training to youth with Pervasive Developmental Disorders (PDDs). This position will involve effective use of crisis communication skills, behavior management strategy, and potential physical restraints.

Job Duties:

- Uses PMT techniques to ensure a safe and therapeutic living environment
- Collect and records Antecedent, Behavior, and Consequence (ABC) data.
- Take an active role in treatment planning process
- Run small or large group house meetings and participate in therapy groups in the House
- Transport residence to off-grounds activities (meetings, medical appointments, etc.)

Qualifications:

Candidate must have an Associate's degree in psychology, social work, criminal justice, or a human service related field and one year of experience working with behaviorally disordered youth. The candidate must be prepared to successfully complete a series of training (PMT, Trauma Informed Care, College of Direct Support modules, mandated reporting, professional boundaries, CPR, and First Aid)
