MONEY-WISE, YOU'RE ALREADY AHEAD OF THE GAME!

Annual Full-Time Tuition & Fees:

- CSCU School -- \$9,300 – 10,016
 - NCCC -- \$4,032
- Just earning your A.S./A.A. in two years before transferring to CCSU will save you a *minimum* of **\$10,000** in tuition and fees alone!

FOUR-YEAR COLLEGE IS EXPENSIVE!

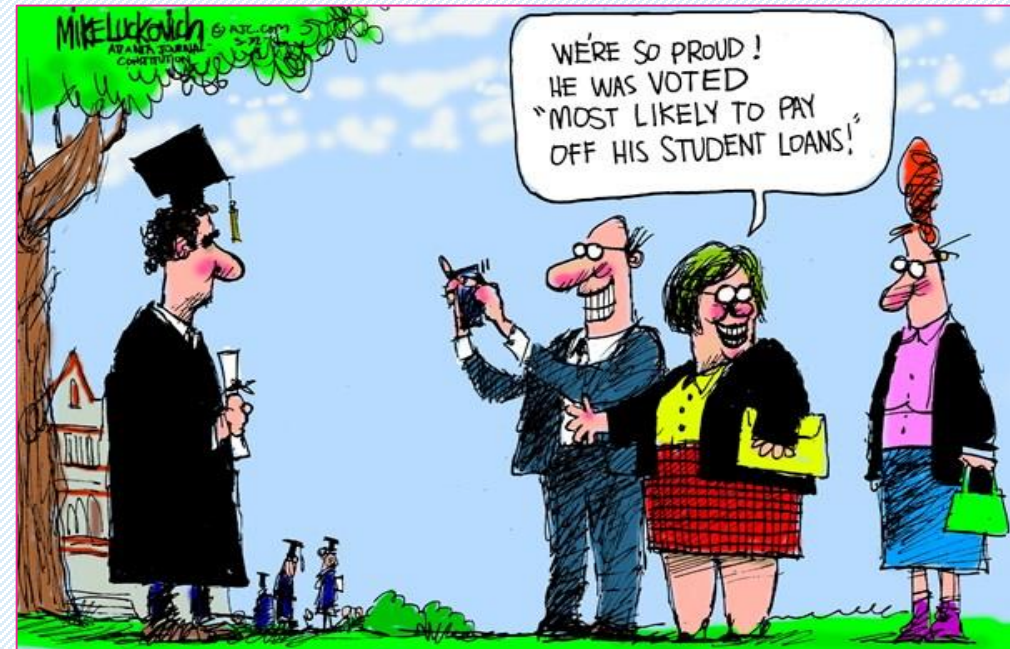
For most **NCCC** graduates, attending a four-year college will be the first time that they will need to borrow money to pay for school.

Student loans are generally a large part of financial aid awards, and need to be repaid, eventually, **with interest.**

FOUR-YEAR COLLEGE IS EXPENSIVE!

A freshmen at Central Connecticut State University takes out an average of **\$6,378** in loans in her first year.

The average **CCSU** graduate will accumulate almost **\$22,894** in loan debt over **four years**.

on time)

amount at the end

Principal (amount at start)

annual interest rate (as a decimal)

time (in years)

number of times per year that interest is compounded

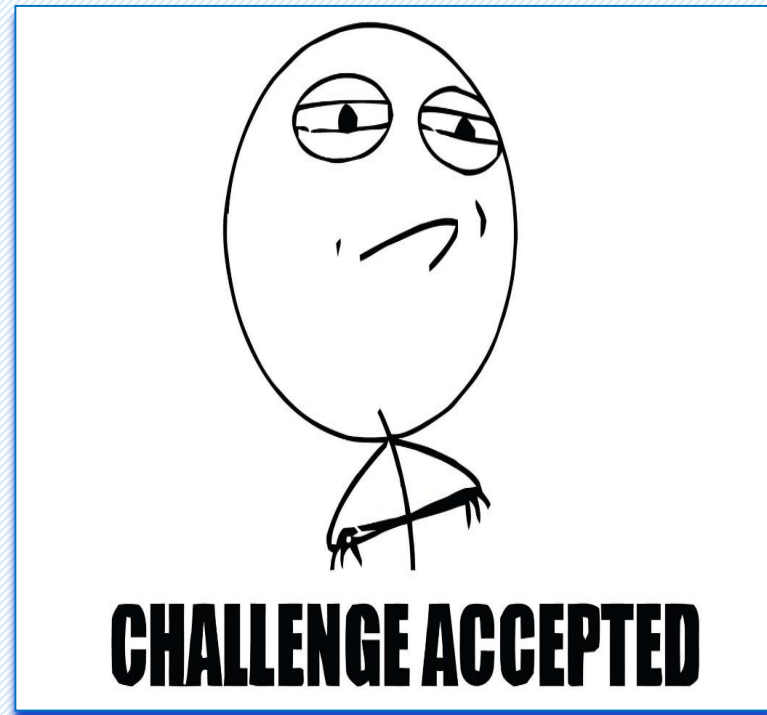
DAP Eligibility Requirements

1. Plan to earn an associate's degree from a Connecticut Community Colleges in **5 years or less.**
2. Plan to pursue a bachelor's degree at a Connecticut State University **within 2 years of completing an associate degree.**
3. Have earned **15 or fewer transferable college credits** at the community college at the time of application

GAP ADVANTAGE 1: GUARANTEED ADMISSION

Academic Requirements

- **DAP** students are guaranteed admission to **a CSU School** upon completion of their associate degree with a **minimum 2.0 GPA**.
- Specific academic and professional programs (**Schools of Business, Education & Professional Studies, and Engineering, Science & Technology**) have additional/higher admission requirements.



DAP ADVANTAGE 2: YOU HAVE A DEGREE!

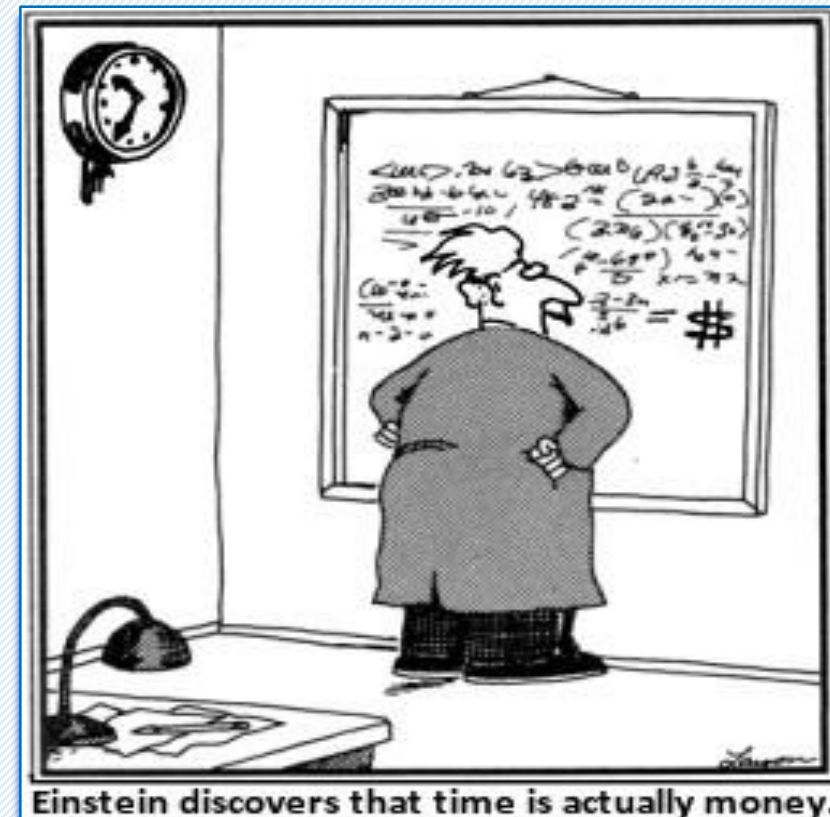
During the remainder of your undergraduate experience, you will have an advantage over students who started at a **CSCU School**.

HOW DO I START THE DAP APP PROCESS?

STEP 1

Complete a **CSCU Community College application for admission** and submit it, along with a check for the required **\$20 application fee.**

If you're currently an NCCC student, you've almost certainly done this already!

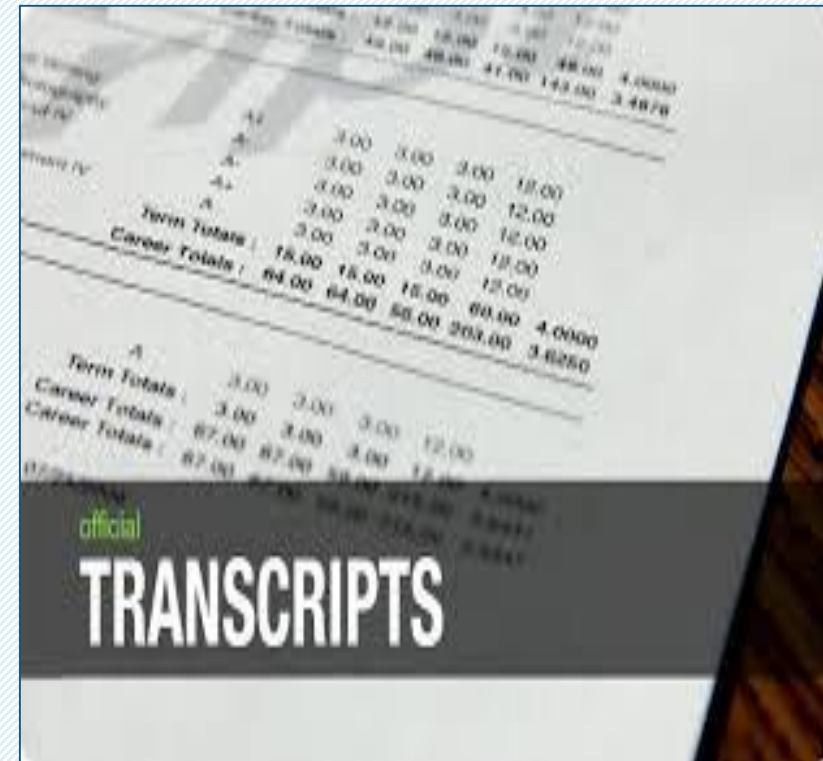


Don't Send Cash!

STEP 2

Collect an **official copy** of your **high school transcript** or **GED**, and **official copies** of transcripts from any *previously attended colleges/universities*.

STEP 3

Complete a **Dual Admission application.**

THE DAP APP PROCESS

STEP 4

Schedule a meeting with the **NCCC Transfer Coordinator**, who reviews your eligibility.

At the meeting, the Transfer Coordinator signs the application, and makes a copy of it.

Finally, **YOU** will mail the completed application and all accompanying materials to **your chosen CSCU School**.



Be sure to attach sufficient postage!

(**FAFSA** due by **March 1st**)

THE DAP APP PROCESS

After **Your CSCU choice** receives your completed **Intent to Enroll** form and **official community college transcript** (as well as official transcripts from any other postsecondary institutions attended), it will send you a **formal letter of admission**.

The CSCU will complete a **transfer credit evaluation**.
