## COURSE SYLLABUS

Course Title: Painting I

Course #: Art 151 61

## Course Description:

Introduction to the principles, processes and materials of oil painting. Topics include paint identification and application, use of color, basic spatial relationships and composition.

## Pre-requisite/Co-requisite: None

**Goals:** To develop basic painting skills and apply compositional principles

Outcomes:

- 1. To obtain a working knowledge of the oil painting process
  - **2.** To explore the properties of oil paint
  - **3.** To identify, mix and apply colors
  - **4.** To learn and apply basic color terminology and color scheme hue, value, intensity, monochromatic, complementary.
  - 5. To develop the critical vocabulary necessary to discuss a painting
  - 6. To apply composition principles to studio problems
  - 7. To solve studio problems involving figure ground, basic spatial relationships, non local color and markmaking.
  - 8. To gain exposure to great painters and paintings from the history of art
