Students will execute a portfolio of paintings with a **Course Description:** focus on the relationship between form (principles,

format, media and processes). Students will reference

the work of past and contemporary artists in their

investigation. Mixed media concepts are introduced.

Pre-requisite/Co-requisite: Art 151 and Art 152, or permission of the instructor

Goals: To apply contemporary concepts and to create a

portfolio of paintings.

To research the work of contemporary artists in terms of form and content.

Outcomes:

1. Construct paintings which communicate personal content by choosing particular formats, media and processes

- 2. Create a series of paintings based on an articulated intention, concept, or inspiration
- 3. Describe the relationship of form to content in the work of contemporary artists who use paint as an integral medium
 - 4. To document one's creative process through journal or an alternative process
