Course Title: Student Teaching II Course #: ECE: 291

Course Description: 3 credits

Course Description:

This is a continuation of Student Teaching I. A student work experience of 100 hours is required. During this phase of work experience, the student will concentrate on working directly with young children. The student will be under the Supervising Teacher as well as the College Instructor. Weekly seminars will be required and will provide the student an opportunity to discuss overall issues in their assigned placement. Prerequisites: ECE 101, ECE: 173, and three or more additional ECE courses and a minimum 2.5 grade point average in Early Childhood Education Courses.

Course Objectives:

1. To provide an opportunity for the student to understand the relationship between theory and practice in an Early Childhood classroom.
2. To objectively evaluate his/her own teaching style and values about teaching.
3. To develop team teaching strategies in an Early Childhood classroom.
4. To gain an understanding of the changing family through practical experience.
5. To develop a variety of techniques for effective classroom management.
6. To promote a continued awareness of the importance of professionalism in the field of Early Childhood Education.
7. To plan, organize, implement and evaluate activities on a weekly basis.
