3 semester hours

- Competence in writing papers that demonstrate that students are able
  - o to do a close reading of a text
  - o to use literary criticism and other primary & secondary materials to interpret the text and its context.
- Independent critical thinking directed at the comprehension and criticism/analysis of literature.
