COURSE SYLLABUS

Course Title: Field Experience in Deaf Studies

Course #: DSC* 222

Course Description: Student work experience of sixty (60) hours in an agency providing services for Deaf people under the supervision of the staff of the agency and the instructor. The instructor will help place and evaluate the students in an approved agency. Meet one hour a week in the class or as the instructor determines.

<u>Pre-requisite/Co-requisite</u>: Prerequisites: ASL* 102, DSC* 114 (both with a grade of "C" or above.) Co-requisites: ASL* 202, DSC* 101, DSC* 214, and DSC* 218.

- **Goals:** Students will be able to:
 - 1. practice direct service provision in working with Deaf people.
 - 2. develop skills in analyzing various situations and the appropriate communication method/approach required.
 - 3. develop contacts/experience in the field for future employment opportunities.

Outcomes: Upon successful completion of this course students should be able to:

- 1. demonstrate effective use of individual and team workplace skills.
- 2. educate others with information on deafness and available resources.
