Course Title: Graphic Design Portfolio Course #: GRA 291

Course Description

(6 studio hours) An independent study course designed to fit the individual needs of each student. Students will be placed in an internship. A mentor and the instructor will monitor progress. Permission from instructor and eportfolio required.

Pre-requisite/Co-requisite: GRA* 253 AND ART* 243 or ART* 272, all with a "C" or better, AND consent of instructor..

Goals: Students will discover techniques to structure their creativity through the process of photography and be able to articulate their artistic process with images and words.

Outcomes:

- 1. Students will produce design work in compliance with internship specifications.
- 2. Students will perform technical operations as called for by the internship.
- 3. Student will be able to operate technology and software as needed by the internship.
- 4. Students will construct page layout and graphic design projects for the internship.
- 5. Students will present a final e-portfolio of finished design work that expresses a personal style and unique creativity.
