Course Title: Life Span Development Course #: PSY\* 201

**Course Description:** This course will examine physical, social-emotional and cognitive development from conception through old age.

Pre-requisite/Co-requisite: PSY 111

**Goals:** Upon completion of this course the student will be able to:

- 1. Outline the physical, cognitive, moral, and psychosocial developmental changes and milestones of the individual throughout the life span
- 2. Discuss how knowledge of life span development information and theory can inform decision-making within individuals, families, schools, health and social service systems and the larger community.
- 3. Discuss how knowledge of life span development information and theory can be applied to practice in various professions.

**Outcomes:** Distinguish and differentiate the interrelated influences of culture, heredity, physiology, environment and social setting on development throughout the life span
