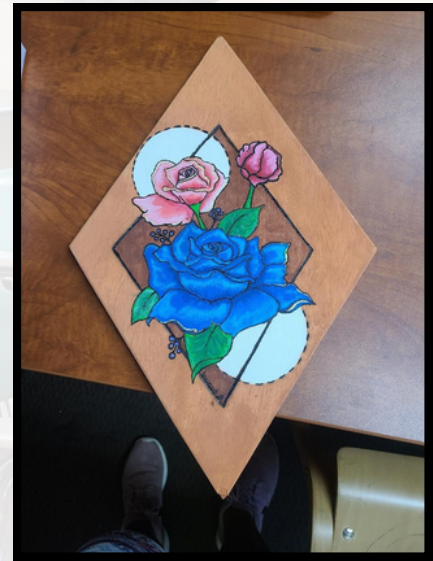

Mental Health and Wellness staff are here to create an inclusive environment to provide equitable mental health support and wellness service to all CT State students.



Wellness Services We Offer:

✓ Crises Response
In-Person, TimelyCare Talk Now and calling 988

✓ Free, Confidential, Short-Term In-Person Counseling Services. Make an in-person appointment with a Campus Wellness Counselor. Five individual in-person sessions per semester (10 session limit per year).

- Students are eligible for services enrolled in the current term for which they are seeking services.

- Telehealth services are available through TimelyCare

✓ Mental Health and Wellness Trainings

- Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST)
- Mental Health First Aid (MHFA)
- Question Persuade, Refer (QPR)

✓ Online Mental Health Screenings
